Tennessee Right to Life Endorses Rich for State House

“Candidate Shares Commitment to Restoring Stricken Laws”

(Nashville) The state’s oldest and largest pro-life organization announced its official endorsement of candidate Barrett Rich for the 94th district state House seat. Speaking on behalf of the organization, Tennessee Right to Life president Brian Harris joined with other affiliate leaders to make the public announcement.

“With the election of Barrett Rich, voters in Fayette, Hardeman and Tipton counties have a unique opportunity to continue a legacy of principled pro-life leadership from the 94th district,” said Harris. “Based on Barrett’s active involvement with Tennessee Right to Life, we know that he is the natural candidate to represent those pro-life convictions in Nashville.”

“Barrett represents the ideals of our movement and we know that he will be an outstanding advocate for the protection of life in our state,” said Karen Brukardt, legislative liaison for the organization.

Election of pro-life leaders is all the more critical considering recent debate on SJR 127, a proposed amendment resolution calling for a public vote on abortion regulation in Tennessee. The resolution has passed the Senate four times but has been opposed and defeated each time in the House by pro-abortion Democratic leadership despite the sponsorship and support of a majority of state House members. Rich supports allowing a public vote.

“We are confident that Barrett Rich will help to lead the fight to restore common sense balance to Tennessee’s current radical policy of abortion on demand,” said Harris. **“We urge every pro-life voter to actively support his election.”**
